- Formerly known as Children's Medicaid
- Children 0-143% FPL
- Children up to age 19
- HMK Plus provider reimbursement rate
- HMK Plus Benefits

HMK current information

- Formerly known as CHIP
- Children 144-261% FPL
- Children up to age 19
- HMK provider reimbursement rate
- HMK Benefits

About Healthy Montana Kids Plan

- Free or low-cost health coverage for Montana children and teens up to age 19
- Covers pre-existing conditions
- Covers care, including, but not limited to :
 - Immunizations
 - Well-child checkups
 - Vision care
 - Dental care
 - Prescriptions
 - Hospital stays
 - Physicals
 - Lab and x-ray services
 - Ambulance services
 - Mental health services

NOTE: Benefits for HMK and HMK *Plus* are similar but not all benefits are the same.

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How to Become a HMK Provider

- Contact BCBSMT to sign up as a HMK medical provider. The BCBSMT provider customer service phone number is 855-313-8914.
- Contact XEROX to sign up as a HMK dental or eyeglass provider. The HMK and HMK *Plus* dental networks are not the same. The XEROX provider relations phone number is 800-624-3958.

MATH Web Portal Information

- Information about both HMK and HMK *Plus* is found in the Montana Access to Health (MATH) web portal.
- Children's HMK *Plus* enrollment will appear as "Medicaid", while HMK enrollment will show as "HMK/CHIP".
- Providers should always check children's enrollment in the web portal before providing services.

HMK Plan Benefits

Differences between HMK and HMK *Plus* benefits

- HMK and HMK *Plus* have different Centers of Excellence for out-of-state hospital services.
- HMK is not available for insured children.
- HMK and HMK *Plus* have non-interchangeable prior authorization processes.
 - HMK *Plus* uses Mountain Pacific Quality Health Foundation for prior authorization (PA).
 - HMK uses BCBSMT for PA.
 - If a child's eligibility changes mid-treatment, they will need to reauthorize their treatments.

HMK Plan Benefits

Differences between HMK and HMK *Plus* benefits

- HMK and HMK *Plus* have different provider networks.
- If a child's eligibility changes mid-treatment, they may need to change providers.
- HMK requires prior authorization from BCBSMT for out-of-state services. Please keep this in mind when referring children to specialists.
- HMK *Plus* is subject to the Passport Program.
- HMK is not subject to the Medicaid EPSDT rules.

HMK Plan Benefits

Differences between HMK and HMK *Plus* benefits

- HMK does not cover orthodontia.
- HMK requires prior authorization for therapies, while HMK *Plus* does not.
- Dental anesthesia or eyeglass add-ons require prior authorization from Gail Moloney.
- Pharmacies dispensing medical supplies, such as diabetic supplies or inhaler spacers, must sign up with BCBSMT to be a medical supply provider. Claims for these supplies may be sent to BCBSMT as an electronic claim or paper CMS-1500.

HMK Billing - XEROX

- The following HMK services are billed to XEROX:
 - Dental,
 - Pharmacy,
 - Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC) and Rural Health Clinic (RHC) services, and
 - Community Based Psychiatric Rehabilitation and Support.
- Claims may be submitted electronically or mailed to Claims Processing, P.O. Box 8000, Helena, MT, 59604.
- HMK Provider questions for these HMK services should be directed to XEROX Provider Relations at 800-624-3958.

HMK Billing-BCBSMT

- Claims for most HMK medical and mental health services are billed to Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Montana (BCBSMT), PO Box 4309, Helena MT 59604.
- Claims may be submitted electronically or mailed to BCBSMT.
