WHO TO COUNT FOR HOUSEHOLD SIZE: For Former Foster Care: County only the individual. For Pregnant Woman: Include the woman, the unborn child/children, the father of the unborn (if married and present in the household) and any other children (of the unborns married parent) under age 19 who live in the household. For HMK, HMK Plus, or Parent/Caretaker Relative: Include all those on the application connected by **Marriage** or **Parentage** who live in the household, along with the unborn children. Include parents (natural, adoptive, step); dependent children living in the household (birth, adoptive, step **under the age of 19**); and unborn children of these persons. A significant other who is the parent of a child/children in the household (other than unborns) should be counted. **DO NOT INCLUDE** other adult relatives who file their own tax return. For Breast and Cervical Cancer: Income and household size do not need to be evaluated for PE since they are reviewed during the Breast and Cervical Cancer screening process.
