Family Planning Clinics, Public Health Clinics, Group Clinics

Family Planning Clinic Billing Opportunity Will Expire on August 1, 2010

The Department published a provider notice concerning Family Planning Clinic Medicaid billing changes July 23, 2009. Family Planning Clinics were notified at that time of enrolling and billing requirements. They were also given the opportunity to bill certain claims directly to the Department and timely filing would be waived. These claims must fall into one of the three categories below:

- Have a date of service more than one year old (as of July 23, 2009); and
- Have a date of service on or after May 23, 2007; and
- Were not paid due to enrollment issues.

However, this billing opportunity will expire on August 1, 2010. That is one year from the effective date of the establishment of the Family Planning Clinic provider type. Timely filing will not be forced on claims meeting the criteria above that are date stamped effective August 1, 2010.
