# Montana Health Care Programs Notice

## Mental Health Centers, 1915(i) Providers, and PRTFs

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### Community-Based Psychiatric Rehabilitation and Support (CBPRS) Clarification

This notice serves as clarification for current Administrative Rule of Montana (ARM) 37.87.701.

ARM 37.87.701(5)(a) states that CBPRS is not allowable during Comprehensive School and Community Treatment or partial hospital program hours.

Medicaid youth who are actively enrolled in a CSCT program may not receive CBPRS services during regular CSCT school hours, regardless of whether or not the youth have received CSCT services within that particular day and regardless of the provider providing the services.

When a CSCT team isn't able to fulfill the requirements of ARM 37.106.1956 (5), (6), (7), and (8), the youth will need to be unenrolled in CSCT and unbundling of services is appropriate.

### Montana Child and Adolescent Needs and Strengths (CANS)

The laminated Montana CANS Practice Reference Sheet in the front of the CANS binders that providers receive during their certification training has been revised.

The section labeled Montana CMHB CANS Policy has been removed. Providers should refer to Administrative Rule specific to the service they are providing for current requirements.
