**WHO TO COUNT FOR HOUSEHOLD SIZE:** For **Former Foster Care**: Count only the individual. For **Pregnant Woman**: Include the woman, the unborn child/children, the father of the unborn (if married and present in the household) and any other children (of the unborns married parent) under age 19 who live in the household. For **HMK, HMK Plus, or Parent/Caretaker Relative**: Include all those on the application connected by **Marriage** or **Parentage** who live in the household, along with the unborn children. Include parents (natural, adoptive, step); dependent children living in the household (birth, adoptive, step **under the age of 19**); and unborn children of these persons. A significant other who is the parent of a child/children in the household (other than unborns) should be counted. **DO NOT INCLUDE** other adult relatives who file their own tax return. For **Breast and Cervical Cancer**: Income and household size do not need to be evaluated for PE since they are reviewed during the Breast and Cervical Cancer screening process.
