Medicaid Passport to Health Referrals and Fee Schedules

As of December 1, 2013, provider fee schedules will include a column on the requirement for Medicaid Passport to Health referrals.

Passport to Health is Medicaid's primary care case management program in which one primary care provider coordinates the care of the Passport member.

Providers may check their fee schedule on the Provider Information website to see which procedures require Passport referral. The member's Passport primary care provider can be found on the Montana Access to Health web portal or by calling Provider Relations at 1.800.624.3958.
