Physician Administered Drugs Code Update

Procedure Codes

Effective July 1, 2017, the following device/drugs must be billed with the following new procedure codes:

Q9984 - Kyleena (Levonorgestrel-releasing intrauterine contraceptive system), 19.5 mg.; previously billed with J7999.

Q9985 - Hydroxyprogesterone, NOS (Injection, hydroxyprogesterone caproate, not otherwise specified), 10 mg; previously billed with J7999. This drug will still require an invoice to be submitted for review.

Q9986 - Makena (Injection, hydroxyprogesterone caproate), 10 mg; previously billed with J1725.

Billing the previously billed procedure codes for services provided on or after July 1, 2017 will result in denials.
