## Severe Disabling Mental Illness (SDMI)

Addictive Mental Disorders Division (AMDD) is providing clarification regarding the SDMI covered and reimbursable DSM V diagnosis and the appropriate ICD-10 codes.

Please note the following important guidelines:

1. Diagnostic specifiers of mild, not otherwise specified (NOS), or unspecified; physiological disturbances; or physical factors do not qualify as SDMI.
2. It is the responsibility of the diagnosing practitioner to select the correct ICD-10 code and specifier that is also supported in the documentation.
3. If the primary diagnosis is not the qualifying ICD-10 code with the appropriate specifier and supported in the documentation, the service will be denied.
4. For billing purposes, it is required to specify whether the diagnosis of PTSD is acute or chronic.
