FQHC, RHC, and IHS/Tribal 638 Providers

Effective July 1, 2019

Peer Support Services

Effective July 1, 2019, Montana Healthcare Programs is offering reimbursement to FQHC, RHC and IHS/Tribal 638 facilities for Certified Behavioral Health Peer Support services. All peer support service requirements must be adhered to and are outlined in the final [Addictive & Mental Disorders Division Medicaid Services Provider Manual at https://dphhs.mt.gov/amdd](https://dphhs.mt.gov/amdd).

Peer support services are not considered an FQHC, RHC or IHS/Tribal 638 service and are ineligible to be reimbursed under the PPS or all-inclusive reimbursement methodology. Peer support services will be reimbursed at the fee schedule rate utilizing the Outpatient Prospective Payment System (OPPS) fee schedule.

The department is currently implementing system modifications to unbundled billing of revenue code 911 and ensure peer support services are paid at the fee schedule rate. Once the system updates have been made the department will notify providers to submit claims for reimbursement.

Billing Procedures

Claims must be submitted on a UB-04 claim form using revenue code 911 and procedure code H0038.

The department asks providers please wait to submit claims until all appropriate methodology modifications have been implemented. Any claims submitted before the system changes are complete will not pay appropriately.
