Chemical Dependency

Effective March 1, 2018

Substance Use Disorder treatment procedure codes

This notice is to inform Chemical Dependency Providers, per MAR 37-828, the Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS) codes (H0001, H0004, H2035) will no longer be used for Medicaid and Non-Medicaid Substance Use Disorder (SUD) treatment reimbursement.

H0001 - Assessment
H0004 - Individual Therapy
H2035 - Group Therapy

Providers will need to use the Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) codes (90791, 90837, 90853) for SUD treatment that align with like services and requirements performed by other behavioral health professionals.

90791 - Psychiatric Diagnostic Evaluation
90837 - Psychotherapy with patient, 60 minutes
90853 - Group Psychotherapy
