Effective Retroactively to July 1, 2020

Removal of DLA-20 Requirement from Transcranial Magnetic Stimulation (TMS) Services

Effective retroactively to July 1, 2020, the Daily Living Activities-20 (DLA-20) requirement for TMS has been waived and is no longer a quality measurement requirement. All other service requirement and quality measures for TMS are required as described in the Addictive and Mental Disorders Division Medicaid Services Provider Manual for SUD and Adult Mental Health, [Policy Number 475: Transcranial Magnetic Stimulation \(TMS\)](#) and [Policy Number 475a: Transcranial Magnetic Stimulation \(TMS\) Quality Measures \(QM\)](#).
