Prior Authorizations

New Contact Lens and Eyeglass Review and Approval Process Through Qualitrac Portal

Effective October 1, 2023, contact lenses and eyeglasses requiring a prior authorization will be reviewed by Mountain-Pacific Quality Health (MPQH). Requests must be submitted electronically through the Qualitrac Portal. **Requests that are faxed, mailed, or phoned in will not be accepted**.

If you do not already have access to the Qualitrac Portal, please visit the <u>MPQH website Medicaid Portal Home Mountain-Pacific Quality Healthcare (mpqhf.org)</u> and select Document Library to complete the registration online.

Supporting documentation of medical necessity is **required documentation** that must be included with the request for review.

For Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnostic, and Treatment (EPSDT) reviews, the EPSDT Prior Authorization and Certificate of Medical Necessity form is required. This form can be found on the Forms page of the Provider Information website. The Forms page link is under the Site Index drop-down on the Home page.

Providers are required to ensure forms are complete and all supporting documentation related to the request must be submitted along with the form(s) via the Qualitrac Portal. Incomplete requests cannot be reviewed.
