## **Effective Retroactively to October 1, 2022**

## Montana Assertive Community Treatment (MACT) and Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Services

The Department made manual changes indicating that the Montana Assertive Community Treatment (MACT) could not be billed concurrently with substance use disorder (SUD) outpatient (OP) therapy.

It is not currently required for MACT teams to include a Licensed Addiction Counselor or SUD treatment to be provided directly by the MACT team. Therefore, SUD OP (ASAM 1.0) services can be billed concurrently with MACT services.

All MACT provider and service requirements must be adhered to and are outlined in the <u>BHDD Medicaid</u> <u>Services Provider Manual for SUD and Adult Mental Health, Effective October 1, 2022</u>.
