## **Chemical Dependency and Licensed Addition Counselor Providers**

## **Clarification for Outpatient Treatment Providers**

The Department made changes to the Administrative Rules of Montana (ARM) in February 2021 for substance use disorder (SUD) state approval with the intent to distinguish between outpatient treatment providers and SUD treatment facilities.

Licensed Addictions Counselors (LACs) in private practice may only be state approved as an outpatient treatment provider under <u>ARM 37.27.107</u>.

Individual LACs who are state approved as outpatient treatment providers can only be reimbursed for SUD outpatient (OP) therapy using appropriate common procedural terminology (CPT) codes.

Refer to the <u>SUD Outpatient (OP) Therapy (ASAM 1.0) policy</u> in the <u>BHDD Medicaid Services Provider Manual.</u>

Only SUD treatment facilities staffed with the appropriate professionals from multiple disciplines can offer other SUD treatment services (ASAM 2.1 and above), as described in the <a href="BHDD Medicaid">BHDD Medicaid</a> Services Provider Manual.
