Audiologist and Hearing Aid Dispenser Providers

Billing for Hearing Aid Dispenser Services – Appropriate Taxonomy and Required Modifiers

Montana Healthcare Programs has identified a noticeable increase in hearing aid dispenser claim denials for the reasons below:

- **Incorrect Rendering Provider Taxonomy**

- Montana Healthcare Programs requires providers to enroll for each category of service provided. Therefore, even if a provider is an enrolled audiologist, to provide and be reimbursed for hearing aid services, they must also enroll as a hearing aid dispenser.
- Providers are reminded to bill with the correct taxonomy associated with the service rendered and their enrollment record.

- **Missing Modifiers**

- The HCPCS codes for monaural hearing aids require the use of modifiers to identify whether the aid is for the left (LT) or right (RT) ear. Use of the modifiers is mandatory for payment of monaural hearing aids.
- Monaural hearing aids billed without the LT or RT modifier will be denied.
