Durable Medical Equipment (DME), Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnostic and Treatment (EPSDT), Indian Health Service (IHS), Mid-Level, Pharmacy, Physician, and Tribal 638 Providers

Monthly Supply Allowance for Continuous Glucose Monitors – A4238 or A4239

Montana Healthcare Programs has identified a noticeable increase in denied claims and questions on billing the supply allowance for continuous glucose monitors (CGMs).

The monthly supply allowance for adjunctive (A4238) and non-adjunctive (A4239), non-implanted CGMs, includes all supplies and accessories, and is considered one unit of service. These codes cannot be billed more than once per month.

Providers are reminded to refer to the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services <u>Article - Glucose Monitor - Policy Article (A52464)</u>.
